

# The Uniform – and Where to Get It!

## **2015-16 Edition**

**Why?** Our Scout uniform identifies us as part of the larger Boy Scout community, gives us a visible sense of unity, symbolizes the values of Scouting, provides a place to display our achievements, and allows us to show our pride in being members of such a great organization. The uniform also helps level the playing field for kids from different socioeconomic backgrounds – we stand together, we dress alike, all for one and one for all!

**What?** Pack 62 requires:

1. The blue uniform shirt (*we recommend choosing a short-sleeved shirt sized for your Scout to wear for a few years*)
2. Rank appropriate neckerchief (*see chart below*)
3. Slide (*there is an official slide, but any will work*)
4. Uniform Patches
  - A. World Crest 
  - B. Council Strip (*any Longs Peak style is acceptable*) 
  - C. Pack Numerals (*a 6 and a 2*)
  - D. Den Numerals (*see chart below*)
  - E. (**optional**) Veteran Unit Bar - Pack 62 is celebrating its 54th year



Pack 62 recommends

1. Scout hat (*see chart below*)
2. Scout belt



For more casual or messy Cub Scout activities (painting projects, sleepovers, hikes, etc.), any shirt with a Scout design is acceptable. The Pack has Pack T-shirts. One will be provided to every Cub Scout. Additional shirts may be purchased at cost for the Cub Scout or other family members.

**Right Sleeve.** U.S. flag (already sewn on), den numeral or den emblem, if applicable, and Quality Unit Award (if earned). Only the most recently earned Quality Unit Award may be worn. Webelos Scouts may wear the Webelos colors immediately below and touching the U.S. flag if no den numeral is worn. If den numeral is worn, wear colors below and touching numeral. Wear Webelos Activity Badge pins on the colors.

**Left Sleeve.** Wear council patch and pack numerals as shown. The veteran unit insignia bar (25, 50, 55, or 60 years) is worn centered below the council patch and above the numeral, and touches both, if applicable. Denner or assistant denner cord is worn over left shoulder.

**Left Pocket.** The World Crest is worn centered between the left shoulder seam and the top of the left pocket. Wear badges of rank as shown: Bobcat, Wolf, Bear, Tiger/Webelos badge. (Webelos replaces Tiger, once earned, if awarded in its diamond form. Webelos badge can also be oval, for placement on the tan shirt alone.) The Arrow of Light Award is centered on the flap or below pocket. Gold Arrow Points are worn beneath the pocket and below the badge for which they were earned. Silver Arrow Points are worn below the Gold Arrow Points in double rows. *If applicable*, wear medals just above pocket seam, and service stars centered just above medals or knots, or 3/8 inch above seam if no medals are worn. Gold background disks are worn with service stars for Cub Scouting service, including Tiger Cub service. The only knots worn by Cub Scouts are the religious emblem knot and a lifesaving or meritorious award knot.

**Right Pocket.** Temporary event patches, Progress Toward Ranks (with thong and beads) for Cub Scouts, or Compass Points emblem for Webelos Scouts are fastened to button under flap of right pocket and flap re-buttoned. The National Summertime Award is pinned centered on the right pocket flap. The Tiger Cubs BSA strip (optional) is worn below the right pocket and above the recruiter strip (if applicable).
